

## Beattyville Fiberglass Animal Project

### ***Artwork Guide Packet - Deadline September 22, 2023.***

#### **Background:**

The fiberglass animals project started in fall 2022 as a partnership project between Beattyville Main Street and Lee County Tourism. The animals were ordered and after months of waiting, were delivered to Beattyville in June 2023. In July, representatives of the Beattyville Main Street and Lee County Tourism meet with artist Jordan Justice, who is experienced with this art medium and also worked on the Pikeville Bears Art Project. Jordan is serving as the artist advisor and will assist with the selection and mentorship of local artists for the Beattyville fiberglass animal art project. Once completed and installed, the animals will be attractive works of art for visitors and locals alike to take photos with and post on social media to promote our community and build community pride.

#### **The animals:**

- Large Standing Cow. Dimensions: 5'2" H, 8'L, 28"W  
Artwork guidance: The partnering boards would like artwork to be submitted depicting "The Purple Cow". Scenes honoring the Purple Cow Restaurant, Lee County agriculture, family at the dinner table, etc.
- Large Standing Bear. Dimensions: 66"H, 27"L, 23"D  
Artwork Guidance: Acceptable themes include, military scenes, fireworks, branches of military, firefighters, police, rescue.
- Bobcat. Dimensions: 30"H 48"L  
Artwork Guidance: Acceptable themes include: Lee County High School Athletics, Scenes of School Spirit
- Catfish. Dimensions: 3'L 2'H 9"D  
Artwork Guidance: Acceptable themes include: fishing, boating, kayaking, Kentucky River.

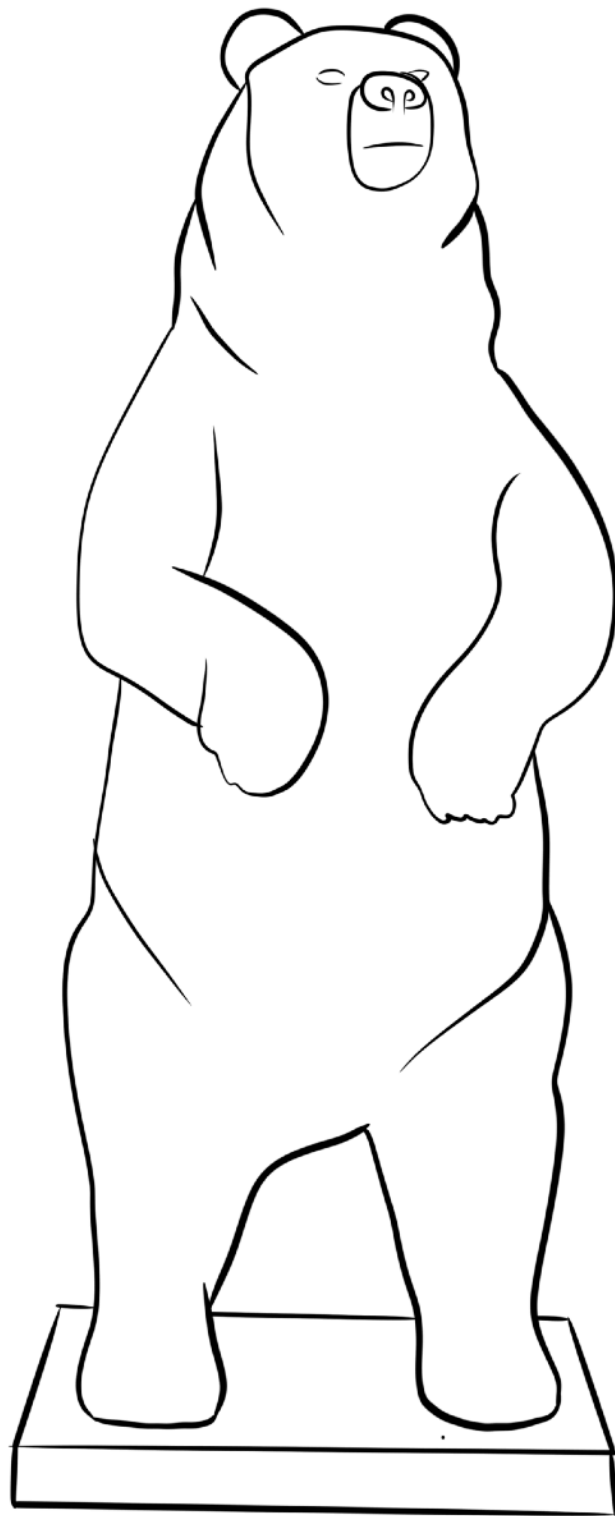
Other - If you have another idea that doesn't fit these themes but wish to submit it then please don't feel bound to the guidance above. We want to see your ideas! The guidance was created after conversations with Main Street and Tourism Board Members as a way to assist artist with ideas and themes that reflect our local community.

#### **The process:**

Please use the template sheets page 2-4 of this packet as a guide for submitting your artwork ideas. After sketches are submitted, we will work with artist Jordan Justice to select artists. The artist may be asked to alter, omit, or add elements to the submitted design. Once a final design is locked in and approved then work can begin. Artist compensation in the form of a stipend, will be based on the size of the statue, amount of paint, and estimated hours to complete. Half to be paid up front and half when the project is complete.

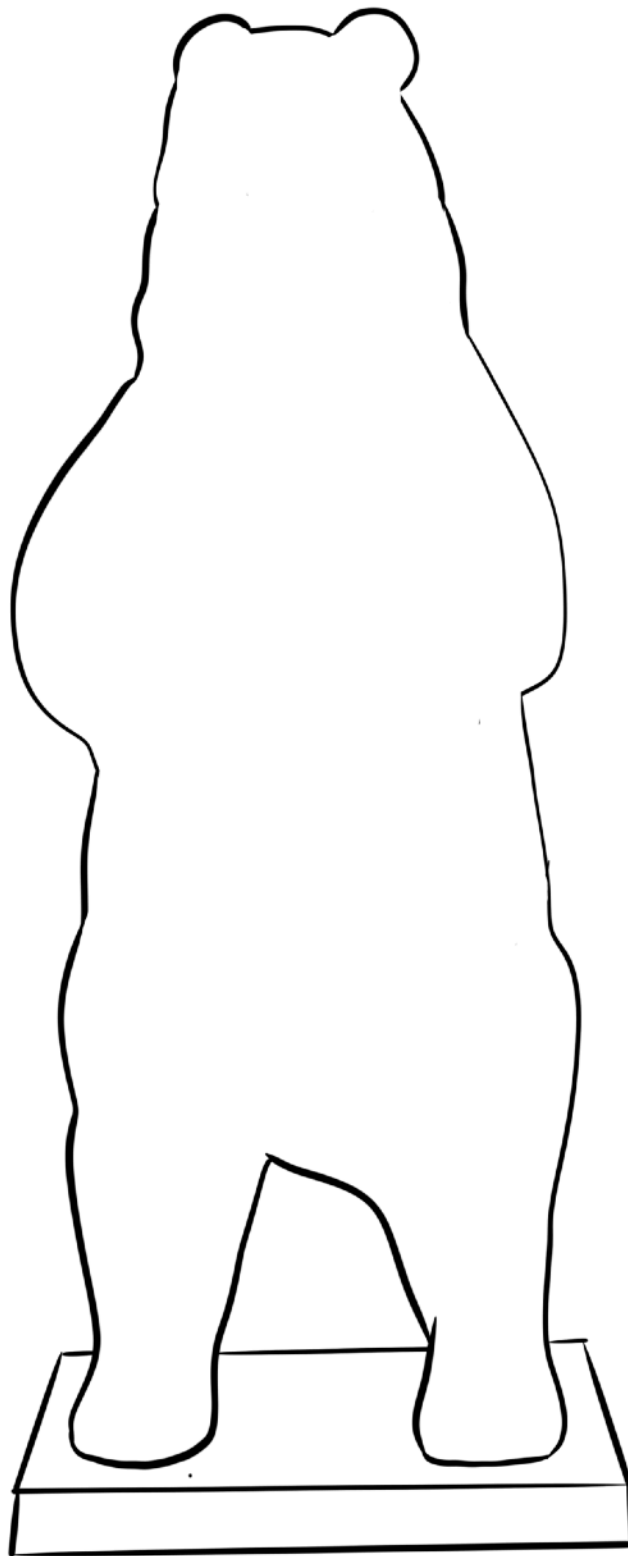
